Fishguard Bay –Getting There.....

By Ferry: The Hotel overlooks the Harbour. From the Ferry Port at the first roundabout take the third exit. Go over the railway bridge; bear right at the next corner: the Hotel is signed about half a mile further on.

NB: There will be a pick up for foot passengers

By Train: There is a regular service to Fishguard. WWBA will organise lifts from Station on Friday

By Car From East: M4 A48M A40 > Haverfordwest. Continue towards Fishguard. Remain on A40 and after Scleddau, take the first turn at the next roundabout; take the first turn at the next roundabout; the sea will be on your right**continue as below **



From North: Cardigan - A487 South: After Dinas; descend a steep hill into Lower Fishguard; pass over the river Gwaun; up a steep hill to small roundabout at Fishguard town square; take the second left turn off and follow the road through Fishguard until you arrive at next roundabout; take the second turn off the roundabout; **the sea will be on your right:go straight across the next roundabout; over a railway bridge, bear right at the next corner; The Fishguard Bay Hotel can be found along a private road after around half a mile.
